- Sequoyah had a trading post were he showed compassion by allowing people to pay later if they did not have money.
- Sequoyah created the Cherokee Alphabet or Syllabary.
- He showed patience because he had to work on it for many years.
- Sequoyah traveled from village to village to teach his alphabet to the Cherokee people.
- The alphabet was important because the Cherokee were able to write down their stories instead of just keeping them in their heads.
